BOARDERS' GUIDE

A. Benefits of Boarding

At St Stephen's College we are committed to turning out well-rounded graduates. For students who participate in our regular boarding programme, they receive the benefits of:

Learning to be independent

Boarders learn to take care of themselves independently through their daily disciplines, routines, and good personal hygiene. Boarding provides the experience of a 'home away from home'.

Polishing communication skills

Boarders are able to polish and enhance their social skills through peer interaction. There will be many opportunities for collaboration and building teamwork.

Self-discipline

Boarders learn to better manage themselves through a strict timetable with healthy routines.

Life-long learning

Boarders are encouraged to explore and learn proactively through self-initiated activities. Each dormitory creates a microcosm within which boarders learn how to cope with different styles and thinking, and work together for the good of the whole community. By living closely with peers, boarders are encouraged to explore and experiment with different ways of learning and interacting under the appropriate guidance and supervision of our staff.

B. Objectives of Boarding

More specifically, boarding enables students to:

- develop self-confidence and intrinsic motivation;
- develop effective communication skills;
- develop collaboration skills with others;
- build life-long friendships;
- live independently;
- develop talents through exploration;
- learn to create boundaries and to respect others;
- develop healthy habits; and
- adopt a healthy and sustainable lifestyle.

C. Pastoral Care

The Warden, the Deputy Warden, Dormitory Wardens, Assistant Wardens, Dormitory Officers, janitors and Boarder Prefects collaborate closely to ensure that each boarder receives the utmost supervision, guidance and care. Boarders live in close proximity with Dormitory Wardens. Each dormitory has a live-in Dormitory Warden who looks after boarders' safety and discipline at all times.

Junior boarders are divided into small groups, known as wards, and they are led by Assistant Wardens. The Assistant Wardens are mentors who meet with their wards on a weekly basis. They may also organise outings with boarders. The group meetings are an opportunity for the boarders to share their thoughts and struggles so that they can be positively counseled to become responsible and respectable youngsters. Activities like sports competitions, talent shows are organised from time to time to enrich their boarding life and expand their social circles.

D. Boarding Activities

Strict prep-times are imposed to ensure that every boarder will strive academically. Occasionally, there will be special events like Talent Show, Christmas Carol singing, barbeques, Sports Night, and outdoor activities for boarders to allow them to relax and enjoy themselves.

Boarders are also encouraged to participate in the College's extra-curricular activities regularly so that they can fully utilize campus facilities. The campus has a wide variety of sports facilities such as a football field, running track, swimming pool, gym room, basketball courts, badminton courts, volleyball court and ping pong tables. For boarders who are musically talented, the College has a strong music programme with a treble choir, mixed choir, strings orchestra, and individual lessons for a wide variety of instruments.

E. Facilities

All the dormitories are on-campus and equipped with up-to-date facilities. Wireless broadband is available and each room is air-conditioned. Boarders are also allowed to use all the facilities on campus until 6 P.M. every day. These facilities include:

Boarders will eat in the Dining Hall. Their food is prepared daily by a professional catering company. The menus are well balanced with an ample amount of vegetables, meat, fish, rice, and fruits. Boarders are expected to eat well, study well and live well.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

All boarders are expected to use their common sense and to behave properly at all times. They should observe the following rules and regulations. In extreme cases, repeat offenders may be expelled from our boarding community.

- 1. All boarders have a duty to use school facilities properly and keep the dormitory clean and tidy.
 - (a) No graffiti on school properties.
 - (b) Do not post up any notice or poster without permission.
 - (c) Report defeats to the Dormitory Officer or any resident staff immediately.
 - (d) Boarders are liable to the damage of school properties if they are not used properly.
 - (e) Boarders' belongings should be moved out during the summer holiday.
- The dormitory is a place to live and study. Boarders should keep it clean and pleasant at all times.
 - (a) No cooking or eating is not allowed in bedrooms.
 - (b) No ball games are allowed.
 - (c) No audio-visual and musical equipment may be used in boarders' bedrooms.
 - (d) No pets are allowed in the dormitory.
- The dormitory is a place for all boarders to live and learn together. Boarders must behave in a considerate manner. They are expected to protect one another, including their privacy and belongings.
 - (a) Our dormitories are out of bounds to unauthorised persons, including parents and guardians.
 - (b) Boarders can only access to their designated dormitory.
 - (c) Day students are not allowed to enter the dormitory or they will receive severe punishments.
 - (d) Students are not allowed to enter staff quarters without permission.
 - (e) Boarders who contract an infectious disease while in residence should go home immediately to seek medical treatment and to rest until they have fully recovered and are certified as being fit to return to school again by a medical doctor.
 - (f) Taking photos/videos in the dormitories without prior permission is strictly forbidden. Offenders will be suspended from boarding for two weeks. Repeat offenders will be permanently expelled from boarding.
 - (g) Boarders should not keep valuable things in their dormitories. Personal belongings such as wallets, watches, etc. should be kept safe and locked in the wardrobe or locker provided. The College will not be held responsible for loss of or damage to any articles left or stored in the dormitories.
 - (h) Serious misbehaviours, including but not limited to using or being in possession of cigarettes or vapes, alcoholic beverages, pornographic materials, gambling tools, drugs or committing or advocating for participating in a criminal offence, regardless of the place of the incident, will lead to immediate expulsion from the boarding community. In addition, the case may be reported to the police for investigation, whenever necessary.

- (i) Except hairdryers, chargers or registered mobile devices, boarders are not allowed to use other electrical appliances. All electrical appliances must be equipped with a BS1363 plug. For safety reason, electrical adapters are not allowed.
- 4. The dormitory is a place for boarders to grow up and learn together. Self-discipline and mutual respect and support should always prevail.
 - (a) Boarders are to follow and carry out instructions of the Boarder Prefects.
 - (b) Courtesy and respect should prevail at all times. Annoying behaviours should be avoided.
 - (c) Be honest to others, especially Boarder Prefects and boarding staff.
 - (d) No lying or concealing the truth.
 - (e) Foul languages or discrimination of any kind are strictly prohibited.
 - (f) Bullying of any kind or fighting is strictly prohibited.
 - (g) No stealing or taking belongings from others without permission.
 - (h) Audio visual equipment can only be brought into the dormitory after obtaining an approval from the Dormitory Officer. Unauthorised items may be confiscated and they have to be collected by parents/guardians in person.
- 5. Boarders should learn how to adopt a low carbon and sustainable lifestyle in the dormitory.
 - (a) All electrical appliances should be switched off when they are not in use.
 - (b) Keep the bedrooms properly ventilated, especially when the weather permits.
 - (c) Live simply through minimising the use of resources. Recycle, whenever possible.
- 6. Boarding life promotes healthy and self-disciplined life habits. Boarders are strongly encouraged to be fully immersed in activities organised by the College.
 - (a) Boarders are required to carry the Student ID Card at all times as it will be used for taking attendance, accessing to the dormitory, and leaving the campus (for those who have applied for leave only).
 - (b) Boarders may leave the College campus only after obtaining permission from the Dormitory Officer. They must dress properly when they leave and report to the Dormitory Officer when they return.
 - (c) Boarders are not allowed to go swimming on the beach. Only boarders who have been given permission by their parents / guardians are permitted to swim at the Wilson Wang Sports Centre. When boarders go, they must also obtain prior permission from the Dormitory Officer.
 - (d) Boarders should not leave the dormitory before 7:30 A.M. without permission.
 - (e) After morning inspection, boarders should leave the dormitory and proceed to the Boarders' Dining Hall for breakfast. No boarders are allowed to stay in or enter the dormitory between 8:20 A.M. and 3:40 P.M. on normal school days.
 - (f) Be punctual to take roll call and have meals in the canteen.
 - (g) Though boarders may put on casual wear after lessons, they must dress properly at all times. Slippers and vests are not allowed in the canteens. Boarders must wear proper school uniform in attending chapel service.
 - (h) During their study leave, S6 boarders may stay in the library or dormitory for studying. However, they must put on school uniforms during lesson hours.

POINTS TO NOTE FOR BOARDERS

Morning Inspection

- 1. Morning inspection is conducted by an Assistant Warden and/or Boarder Prefects at 7:30 A.M. every school day.
- 2. Boarders should wake up at 7:00 A.M. or before that. Morning bell rings at 7:00 A.M. every school day.
- 3. Before inspection, boarders should have stripped their beds, had a wash and brush-up, tidied up their belongings, and put on proper school uniforms.
- 4. When the inspection bell rings, boarders should stand outside their bedrooms. Align in single files and keep quiet during inspection.
- 5. Inspection and health check should be conducted by the Assistant Warden and/or Boarder Prefects.

Nighttime Inspection

- 1. Nighttime inspection is conducted by the Dormitory Officer and/or Boarder Prefects at 10:00 P.M.
- 2. Before inspection, boarders should have cleaned themselves and tidied up their belongings.
- Inspection and health check should be conducted by the Dormitory Officer and/or Boarder Prefects.

Prep Time

- 1. Refer to "Part F Routines for Boarders" for the study time.
- 2. Boarders should either do his/her school work or read the school textbooks in the first prep. Discussion or project work should not be conducted in this session.
- 3. Listening to music is not allowed.
- 4. Boarders should keep quiet during the preps and they should not enter other bedrooms, unless they have obtained permission from Boarder Prefects.
- 5. Except for attending boarding activities or unless a permission has been obtained from the Assistant Warden or the Dormitory Officer, no boarders should leave the dormitory after 7:15 P.M.

Meals

- 1. All boarders must attend meals in the dining halls, except the S5-6 boarders who have applied for having lunch outside campus. Punishment will be given to absentees.
- 2. Boarders must dress appropriately though they are not required to wear school uniform at mealtimes after school. On the days when boarders have to attend Chapel Services, they must wear proper school uniform. Sleeveless singlets, tights, short skirts/dresses, tightly fitting sports shorts/pants and slippers are not allowed.
- 3. Attendance will be taken by Assistant Wardens, Dormitory Officers or Boarder Prefects.
- 4. Boarders should minimise the risk of spreading communicable diseases to others during mealtime.
- 5. Boarders should follow the instructions given by staff in the canteens.

Laundry

- 1. Though laundry opens from 7:40 A.M. to 5:15 P.M. on school days, boarders can only send or collect their laundry in person during the following time slots: (a) 7:45 8:15 A.M. or (b) 3:40 5:00 P.M.
- 2. Laundry service is provided to boarders according to the following timetable:

CH-A, CH-B & WW: Every Mon, Wed & Fri EW, MH & NH: Every Tue, Thu & Fri

- 3. All items should be labelled with the Student ID using a permanent marker and be placed in a laundry bag. Drop it into the collection box during the abovementioned time slots. Items unmarked or belong to others will not be washed.
- 4. Each boarder should prepare two laundry bags which are white in colour and marked with the Student ID.
- 5. Our laundry does not accept items which require delicate washing, or may cause shrinking or ruin other clothes during washing. These include sweaters, blankets, corduroy fabric, pillows, cotton jackets, or private bedding.
- 6. Each boarder can send a laundry load maximum up to 4 kg each time.
- 7. Boarders are required to present their Student Card in collecting laundry. They should not take laundry for others.
- 8. Boarders should check carefully after collecting their laundries. If there is any item incorrect, please report to the laundry staff at once.
- 9. Laundry service is subject to the amount of dirty clothes received. If an overwhelming amount is received, the laundry service may therefore be delayed.
- 10. Boarders should send their dirty clothes to the laundry or take them home before weekends and holidays.
- 11. The College is not liable to any loss or damage caused by our laundry service.

Staying Overnight on Fridays

- 1. Boarders attending school activities on Saturday morning may apply for staying overnight on Friday. Otherwise, they should return home before 6:30 P.M. on Friday.
- 2. Applicants must inform the Dormitory Officer about the meal arrangements on Friday night and Saturday morning.
- 3. Boarders are not allowed to stay overnight on Saturday.
- 4. Dormitories are closed from 1:00 P.M. on Saturdays until 4:00 P.M. on Sundays.

Sundays/Last Days of Long Holidays

1. All boarders must return to the dormitories by 6:30 P.M. If for any special reason they cannot return by this time, they are required to apply to the Dormitory Officer by submitting a letter of excuse beforehand.

Personal Leave

- 1. Should it be necessary for a boarder to take leave due to personal affairs, he/she must apply for leave, together with proof, from the Deputy Warden or the Dormitory Officer beforehand.
- 2. Boarders must not leave the campus without permission.

Sick Leave

- 1. If a boarder feels unwell in the morning or before attending lessons, he/she should proceed to the General Office and must not stay in the dormitory.
- 2. If a boarder feels unwell after lessons, he/she should report to the Dormitory Officer at once
- 3. If a boarder is infected with a communicable disease, he/she should seek medical consultation at once and take rest at home until he/she fully recovers.
- 4. When the boarder returns from sick leave, he/she should submit the parent letter and the medical certificate (if more than one school day) to the General Office before 8:20 A.M. The boarder should also inform the Dormitory Warden or the Dormitory Officer after school on that day.

Mobile Devices

- 1. Each boarder may bring one registered mobile phone to school only. Registration normally opens in early September.
- 2. If a boarder wishes to bring a computer device (e.g. a laptop) for academic reason, he/she must obtain a prior approval from the Dormitory Officer.
- 3. Unauthorised items may be confiscated and they have to be collected by parents/guardians in person.
- 4. Junior boarders are required to surrender their mobile devices at 10:00 P.M. every school day. They will be kept until the completion of morning inspection on the next day.

Emergency

The following serves as general guidelines for the safety and emergency procedures for boarding staff and boarders to take for reducing the risk of hazard happened on campus.

Fire Precautionary Measures

- 1. All boarders are responsible for minimising the risk of fire in the dormitory.
- 2. Boarders should not bring flammable items to school.
- 3. Boarders cannot use their own extension sockets. Overloading should be avoided.
- 4. Keep fire exits and evacuation routes free from barriers at all times.
- 5. Lighting a fire is strictly prohibited.

Upon spotting a fire, boarders should:

- 1. stay calm, don't run
- 2. alert others by shouting 'fire'
- 3. break the nearby fire alarm glass
- 4. leave the dormitory using the evacuation route
- 5. report to the Dormitory Warden, the Dormitory Officer or the Assistant Warden
- 6. proceed to the following assembly points:

NH - North House Basketball Court

EW & WW - Central Square

MH – Martin Ball Court

CH-A & CH-B - College House car park
